

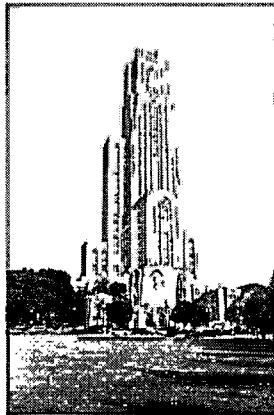

Sophomore Year:

- Consider going to field school in the summer. Archaeology field schools are a good background.
- Consider taking some upper level courses
 - ⇒ Pots and People
 - ⇒ Cultural Resource Management
 - ⇒ Andean Archaeology
 - ⇒ Archaeology of Warfare
 - ⇒ Archaeological Theory
 - ⇒ Archaeology of North America
 - ⇒ Archaeological Data Analysis
 - ⇒ Sedimentology and Stratigraphy
 - ⇒ Paleo-Kitchen
 - ⇒ Origins of Cities

Junior Year:

- Sophomore/Junior year courses overlap a lot. Some course are offered every other year/once a year.
- Go Abroad!
- Begin preparing for the GREs
- Attend Graduate School Night in the Fall and Mentor Me Night in the Spring
- Volunteer in the Archaeology lab or Carnegie Museum.
- It is a really good idea to go to field school.

- Consider applying for a summer research grant.
 - ⇒ The Anthropology department offers funding for undergraduate research in archaeology—ask Prof. Barton
 - ⇒ The honors college offers an Off Campus research award and the Brackenridge Fellowship
 - ⇒ The Dietrich School of Arts and Sciences offers an Undergraduate Summer Research Grant

Senior Year:

- Keep up with coursework
- Make a spreadsheet for grad schools
- Consider applying for TFA, the Peace Corps, or Americorps.
- Ask professors that know you well for recommendation letters
- Prepare for the real world
